In an attempt to make up for PSN downtime and regain customer confidence, Sony is [offering members of the PlayStation Network](#) the option to pick two free games for the PlayStation 3 and two for the PlayStation Portable (PSP) as part of the company's Welcome Back program.

This offer comes while Sony tries to provide customers with a token of appreciation after the Playstation Network was down due to hacker attacks that caused a 3 week outage and a massive data breach of both the PSN and SOE networks.

The games being offered for the PS3 console are: Dead Nation, inFAMOUS, LittleBigPlanet, Super Stardust HD and Wipeout HD + Fury.

The games offered on the PSP handheld are: LittleBigPlanet, ModNation Racers, Pursuit Force and Killzone Liberation.

In addition, the company is offering selected free movie rentals, PlayStation Home items and 30 days of free PlayStation Plus services to non-subscribers.

Current PlayStation Plus subscribers will get 60 days of free subscription and Music Unlimited Premium/Basic. Subscribers will get 30 free days and be compensated for days the network was out.
